



## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Do all sites have to apply?**

All programs (former, existing and new) seeking to become NC Pre-K sites for the SFYs 2016-18 must apply.

### **Is each classroom considered a site?**

Applications are needed from each physical facility. Multiple classrooms located in the **same physical** facility may be included in one application.

### **How does monitoring affect the application for existing sites?**

Monitoring results and DCDEE visits are included in the selection process for currently or previously funded NC Pre-K classrooms/sites.

### **Do private sites have to compensate teachers with the proper, complete credentials according to the NC State Teachers' Salary Schedule?**

Yes. Private sites must agree to compensate NC Pre-K teachers who hold NC BK licensure according to the 2015-16 Wake County SmartStart contract requirements. (attach file)

### **Is there a minimum point range for NC Pre-K Site Selection?**

Not at this time.

### **Must I submit an original, hard copy application?**

Yes! Applications must be received in our office by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>. Electronic submissions will not be accepted.
