## Form 990 Preparation Request for Proposal

**Purpose:** Wake County Smart Start, Inc. is currently seeking a CPA firm to prepare the IRS Form 990 and related schedules for Wake County Smart Start Inc. and six of its MAC sites:

**Scope of Work**: Preparation and electronic submission of Form 990 and related schedules for Fiscal Years Ending 6/30/2021, 6/30/2022, and 6/30/2023. All organizations use the cash basis of accounting.

**Time period:** Drafts of the 990 should be completed by October 1<sup>st</sup> of each filing period and file electronically by the November 15<sup>th</sup> due date.

**Project Costs:** Respondents must propose an hourly rate that would be charged for services along with an estimate of the time required.

**Proposal Requirements:** Proposal should include the following information: a description of professional background and experience preparing tax returns for nonprofit organizations, experience with Smart Start Partnerships, the size and organizational structure of the firm, a description of the tax team, including their position in the firm, total years, and types of experience; a statement of understanding of the work to be performed, including time estimates; references.
